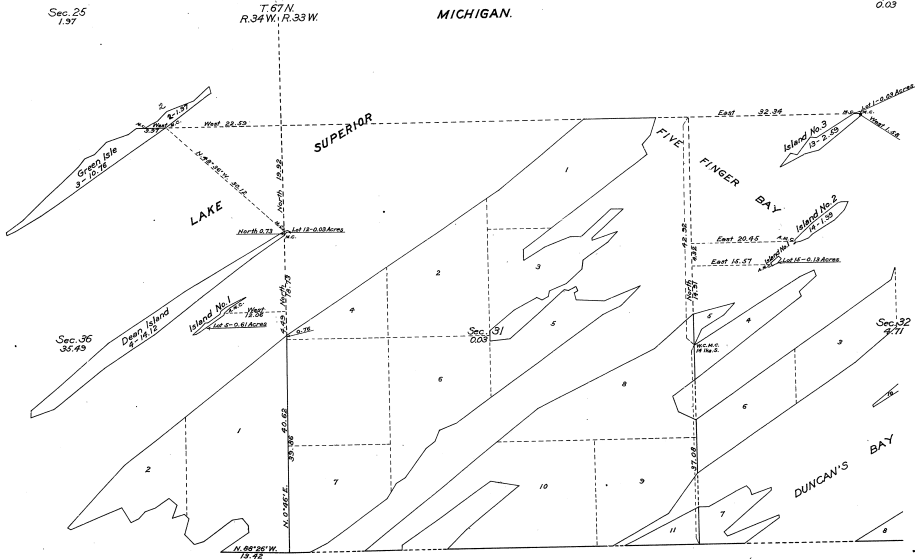




**PLAT OF SIX ISLANDS**
