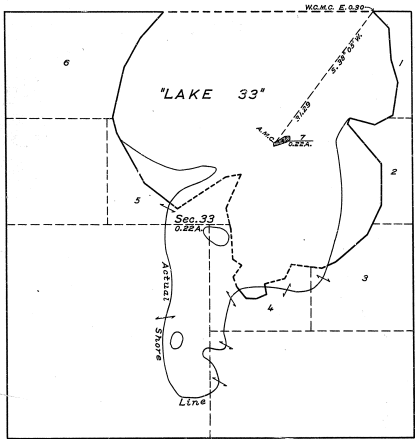

MEMORANDUM.

THIS PLAT REPRESENTS THE SURVEY OF AN ISLAND IN "LAKE 33", WHICH WAS NOT RETURNED AS SURVEYED ON THE TOWNSHIP PLAT APPROVED JANUARY 22, 1853. THE SURVEY WAS EXECUTED PURSUANT TO AUTHORITY CONTAINED IN GENERAL LAND OFFICE LETTER 1109430 "B", DATED NOVEMBER 22, 1925, BEARING DEPARTMENTAL APPROVAL UNDER DATE OF NOVEMBER 24, 1928.

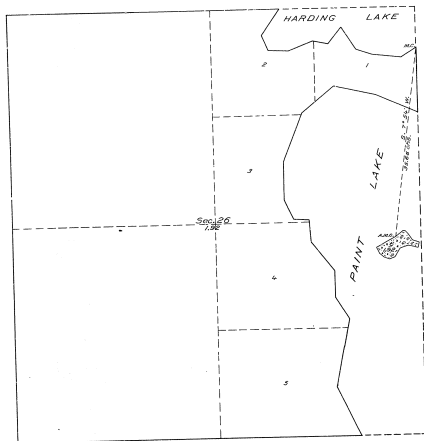
