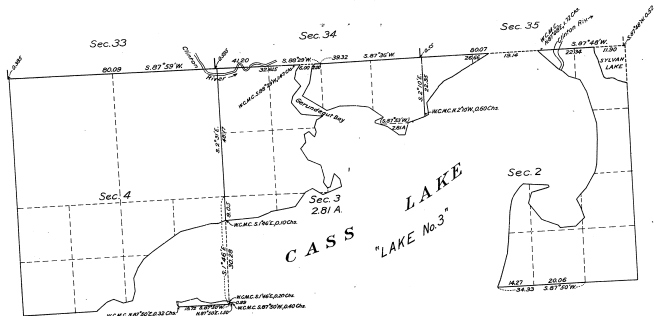

Memorandum

This plot is based upon a meander Survey of Cass Lake in fractional sections 2,3 and 4, T.2N., R.9E., Michigan Meridian, Michigan, the same being shown as a lake upon the official plat approved February 20, 1862, but which was not meandered in the survey executed by Samuel Carpenter, D.S., in 1852. The necessary section lines have been retraced, and the points of intersection of said original lines with the shore line of the lake, as occupied at the date of the original survey, have been monumented as meander corners.

In order to mark the northern boundary of the fractional SE ¼ of the NE ¼ of Sec. 3, (recent public land at the date of the approval of this plat) the surveyor will begin at the witness in the meander corner of fractional Secs. 2 and 3 (monumented) and run S. 23° 47' W, 205 chs. dist. along the present shore line of the lake (estimated to be about 30 chs. to the right of the position of the meander line at the date of the original survey).

Thence S. 87° 53' W, along the calculated position of the East Meander line through the fractional NE ¼ of Sec. 3, to the present shore line of the lake.

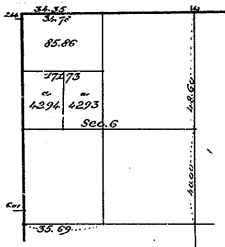

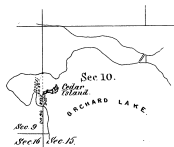
