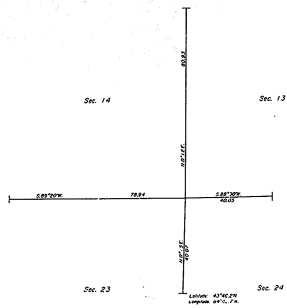

CORRECTIVE DEPENDENT RESURVEY



A history of surveys is contained in the field note record.  
This plat represents the corrective reestablishment of the 1/4 section corner and the corrective establishment of the SW 1/4 section corner between sections 1 and 12, and the reworkment of certain subdivisional lines designed to return the corners to their true original locations according to the best available evidence, T. 15 N., R. 4 W., Michigan Meridian, Michigan.  
The settings and areas are as shown on the plat approved June 7, 1937.  
Survey executed by Stephen G. Douglas, Cadastral Surveyor, beginning April 29, 1936, and completed April 29, 1936, pursuant to Conditional Special Instructions For Group No. 25, Michigan, dated December 12, 1935.
