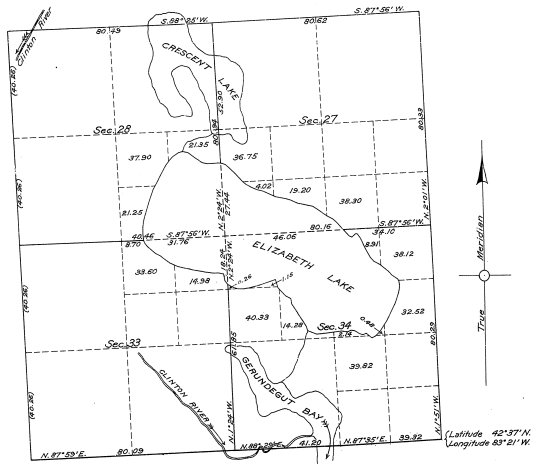

MEANDER SURVEY OF ELIZABETH LAKE
 in Fractional Sections 27, 28, 33 and 34,
 Township 3 North, Range 9 East, Michigan Meridian,

This plat is based upon a meander survey of Elizabeth Lake, the same being shown as a lake upon the official plat approved February 20, 1818, but which was not meandered in the survey executed by Samuel Carpenter, D.S., in 1817. The necessary section lines have been retraced, and the points of intersection of said original lines with the shore line of the lake, as occupied at the date of the original survey, have been monumented as meander corners.

Scale: 20 chains to an inch.
