# Noteworthy

There is plenty of quality holding water here, but be aware of private riparian rights. Stay in the river unless you absolutely have to get out. Some of the larger brook trout that have been caught in the East Branch over the decades have been caught in this area.

## **Fishing Regulations**

This site on the East Branch of the Black River is a designated Type 1 trout stream. Please refer to the Inland Trout and Salmon Stream Regulations in the current Michigan Fishing Guide.

#### **Directions to Site**

From M-33, turn west on CR-622 which is approximately 8.5 miles north of Atlanta. Follow 3.9 miles to turn on right (northwest) which is East Branch Road. Continue on East Branch Road 4.0 miles to Blue Lakes Road and then turn left (west). Barber Bridge is approximately 0.4 mile from this intersection.
