This access site is a State of Michigan designated access site and is well signed. This boat access site has 4 parking spaces, a public toilet and is paved.

Fishing Regulations

The Jordan River is a designated Type 1 trout stream from its headwaters down through Websters Bridge to Pinney Bridge. The fishery here is predominately resident fish, although it is stocked each spring with migratory steelhead.

Directions to Site

About 5 miles south of the town of East Jordan beginning on South Lake Street, Websters Bridge Road is on the east side of Hwy M-66 (brown sign on highway) and heads north for a little under one mile to the access site. Dirt parking lot, stepped access for drift boats, kayaks, or other small watercraft.
