Noteworthy

This site is located adjacent to the Swan Creek Waterfowl Refuge and Allegan State Game Area. Paddlers will find this location amenable to other non-fishing recreational opportunities. There are no public restroom facilities at this site.

Fishing Regulations

Kalamazoo River is not designated as a trout stream in this area, but anglers can catch brown trout and rainbow trout/steelhead that are stocked in the river and tributary streams. Directions to Site

This access site is located off the M-89 Bridge in Allegan County. There is no boat launch, but anglers can access the Kalamazoo River by small watercraft and canoes/kayaks. There is shore fishing opportunities along with wading. Parking is available for up to 10 vehicles.
