#### **Directions to Site**

From the intersection of M-28 and M-77 in Seney, travel west on M-28 for approximately 8 miles and then turn right (heading south) onto Driggs River Road. Travel south on Driggs River Road for approximately 2.1 miles until a three-way interesection is reached. Turn right (heading west) and travel approximately 600 feet until you reach a bridge over the Driggs River. Access the river by using the right-of-way along the road and bridge.
