Noteworthy

This a nice, open canopy river that lends to easy fly fishing opportunities. The river has cascading shallow rock ledges along with sweeping, deep river bends. Fish are often found in the splash pools below rock ledges or in the deep water river bends.

Directions to Site

On State Highway M-28 at the town of Kenton, at a distance of .2 miles east of Kenton, take Forest Highway 16 north for .2 miles to Sparrow Rapids Road on your left (west). Follow this road for 4.2 miles until it ends, then walk 1/4 mile down a dirt gravel path to the river. OR at 3.3 miles down this road enter the Sparrow Rapids Campground and hike the path on the north side of the campground down to the water. The rapids are located near the campground, and the more gentle and deep water is located north where the road terminates.
