Species Description

The Carp River is stocked with both brown trout and steelhead, but natural reproduction of both species occurs. Wild brook trout are also occasionally caught here, but this is primarily a steelhead fishing location. In the fall, you might also catch some Chinook, coho or pink salmon.

Noteworthy

McDonald Rapids has a nice parking area and several trails to and along the river. Flows can be variable here, with higher water in the spring and fall and much lower water in the summer. Generally depths are 1-3 feet, with deeper holes. Substrate is primarily gravel with some boulders. Gradient is fairly high here.
