#### **Species Description**

Although brown trout and steelhead are stocked in the Carp River, the South Branch Carp River is primarily a wild brook trout stream.

### Noteworthy

This site is on the South Branch Carp River just upstream from the confluence with the main Carp River. The South Branch is colder than the mainstem, and supports a good brook trout population. There is also a large campsite/parking area here.

#### **Directions to Site**

Take M-123 north from Moran. Take Burm Road to the west, then turn north on U.S. Forest Service 3458 (aka Nogi A Road). Travel just over a mile, then turn west on U.S. Forest Service 3502 (aka Goudreau Trail). Campsite/parking area is on north side of road.
