I, Robert L. Jamros, in a field survey on November 11, 1998 do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and for that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law, established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

H1: P.L.S. - John Burt, DS, 1841. Set quarter section post. Beech 5, N.66°E., 25 links. Hemlock 14, N.36°W., 14 links. ***** No other record of restoration.

B. Description of comer evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing comer:

H1: Located search area for comer position by standard field survey and single proportionate measurement. Fount squared 6" Cedar post, West 10 feet from comer position (author unknown) and blaze lines North-South and East-West. A search was conducted for GLO evidence, it was determined as lost. Monumented comer position as established, midway on line between section comers ½ mile East and West. Established new reference trees. Comer position as monumented is accepted as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original comer.

C. Description of monument for comer and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the comer:

H1: Set Bernsten aluminum monument no. AINB30 with 4" aluminum cap, stamped to identify comer position. Established new reference trees with BT signs, blazed, scribed and painted. Set PK nails for measure with aluminum I.D. washers in the following * Beech 5", N.10°W., 31.12 feet *1/4S BT"; * Beech 5", N.36°E., 29.75 feet, *1/4S BT"; * Beech 6", N.61 ½°E., 6.16 feet, *1/4S BT"; * Beech 5", S.33 ½°W., 14.54 feet, *1/4S BT". * Survey marker sign on 6 foot steel post, N.60°W., 1.5 feet. * All bearings are magnetic.
