A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Corner established by William Burt on June 30, 1848. Original B.T.s --- B. Ash 10" S.35 E. 11 links (7.26') --- B. Ash 10" N.30 W. 12 links (7.92') --- Corner restored by Richard L. Drahn, RLS 21564 on 10/22/81 from the remains of the two original B.T.s (the first a 21" live Black Ash with GLO blazes). He set a 2" dia. iron pipe monument with a 3" stamped brass cap and the following new B.T.s :--- 13" (16") Cedar N.30 W. (N.31 W.) 36.97' (36.96') --- 7" (9") Black Ash N.65 E. (N.62 E.) 20.96' (20.92') --- 7" (10") Black Ash S.04 W. (S.03 W.) 49.96' (49.92') --- 6' Metal sign post S.04 W. (S.03 W.) 1.8' (1.75') ---

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: 6/15/70.

Bearing objects referenced:

4" Red Maple S.55 E. 6.41'

Act 74 research form on file with Ontonagon County records.

Recovered the monument as described and the bearing trees as noted in parentheses above.

The live B.T. recovered in 1981 is now a cut Black Ash with GLO blazes.
