Janros, in a field survey on November 08, 1994, 19\_\_\_\_\_, do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law, established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

**NOTE: Not more than 4 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.**

**A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:**

C1: PLS-William A. Burt, DS, 1841, Set section corner post of sections 5 and 6, - Tamarack 8", N.47 E., 47 links, Tamarack 12", N.48 W., 35 links. M.S.H.D. Construction Plans for H-58 (old State Highway M-94) 7-14-1958. Corner shown South of Co. Hwy. H-58, (Old State M-94), 975.89 feet to a 2" Iron Pipe w/ cap. W.Pine 24", S.29 E., 10.19', Balsam 7", S.50 W., 16.40', Maple 6", N.31 W., 23.32'. CCI Land Cor. Record No. 1074, J.R. Radcliffe, RLS, 1967, Iron w/ brass cap. New Ref. Maple 5", N.31 W., 34.8 links, W.Pine 22", S.26 E., 14.4 links. Robert L. Janros, RLS, 1988, Found Iron w/ brass cap and Two BT's. References: Maple 10", N.31 W., 23.2 ft., Existing., Pine Stump 30", S.23 E., 10.0 ft., Existing., Balsam 5", N.57 E., 23.2 ft., Hemlock 5", S.17 W., 12.3 ft. Recorded in Corner Record No. 3-339, Alger County Records.

**B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:**

C1: Found 2" cast steel monument with 3 1/4" brass cap marked to identify corner position. A search was made for evidence of GLO BT's, evidence inconclusive. In report of R.L. Janros, 1988, corner position was located by field survey as part of a section subdivision survey. Corner was located from centerline measuring 975 ft. south of County Hwy. H-58 (Old State M-94). There is no record of this monument being set but it is typical of the monuments being used by the County Surveyor for Alger County the early part of this century. The cap was marked well but without a date. Established additional reference trees. Accepted the existing monument as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

**C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:**

C1: Stamped P.A. 345 in brass cap of 2" cast steel monument. Renewed existing and established new reference trees w/ BT signs and paint. Set Pk nails for measure w/ brass I.D. washers in the following reference trees. Ex. Maple 10", N.27 W., 23.14 feet, "Dbl. Blz'd", Ex. Spruce 7", N.60 E., 23.20 feet, "S32 BT", Ex. Hemlock 6", S.21 W., 12.30 feet, "S6 BT", Maple 6", S.62 E., 6.56 feet, "S5 BT", Steel witness post with Survey marker sign, N.50 E., 2.0 feet, All bearings are magnetic.
