A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(I10) Quarter corner common to Sections 26 and 27. 1852 - Established by Z.B.Searles, Deputy. post midway and on the Section line between Section corners 39.98 ch. north and south. Y.Birch 12" S73°W 25 links, Cedar 18" S24°E 8 links. 1944 - N.T.Thompson RLS states that he chained south from I9 2638.7' [note: this would be the record GLO distance -ss] to 1/4 corner and set cedar post with new BTs: Cedar 6" S80°E 10.0', Sugar 4" S45°W 22.8'.

(H10) Center of Section 27. Not previously monumented.

- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
- (I10) The original post and accessories were not recovered. Found a 1"ID I.pipe projecting 2 ft. a.g. at record bearing and distance from the remaining 1944 NBT Cedar, now 13", in good condition. Distance to I9 was found to be 2625.41', distance south to monumented I11 was found to be 2653.85' and I10 is 4.36' east of a straight line between them. Accepted the monument as the position of the corner through it's long use as such.
- (H10) Established the position for the corner at the intersection of straight lines connecting opposite 1/4 corners. From the position thus established, there is a forester's approximate corner (tree with tag marked as such), with blue paint lines running from it to the east and south, S41°E 17 feet distant.
- C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
