I, Stephan J. Szyszkoski, in a field survey on K7 10/22/15 H9 11/02/15 do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(K7) Corner common to Sections 13-14-23-24. 1849 - Established by Wm. Burt, Deputy. Set Sugar post. Y.Birch 15" N67°W 27 links, Cedar 12" S63°E 36 links. 1976 - A.O.Enger, RLS found and accepted a 1"ID Iron pipe during a retracement survey in this township. The pipe was not subsequently witnessed or recorded. Mr. Enger monumented corners J7 and I7, to the west, all three being on a straight line and J7 midway between I7 and K7.

(H9) Quarter corner common to Sections 22 and 27. 1849 - Established by Wm. Burt, Deputy, midway and on the Section line between Section corners 40.41 chains east and west. Set Y. Birch post. Sugar 6" S50°W 13 links, Maple 5" N72°E 25 links. Found no subsequent record.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(K7) The original post and accessories were not recovered. Found a 1" ID iron pipe with mushroomed top on a straight line through the 1976 monuments at I7 and J7 and at a distance from J7 that is substantially that observed between I7 and J7. Accepted same as the 1976 position and as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner. Cut the mushroomed top from the pipe and installed a 2" alum. cap on same.

(H9) The original post and accessories were not recovered. Found no evidence of the position of the original corner on the ground. Reestablished the position for the corner midway and on the Section line between Section Corners 2627.23' east and west. The position falls in the center of a 2-track woods road.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(K7) Found 1"ID Iron pipe, set 2" alum. MDNR cap. Set measuring nail with MDNR tag in the side of:
8" Sugar N12°E 12.6' mrkd "S13 NBT"
5" Sugar S43°E 17.6' "S24 NBT"
5" Maple S05°W 7.4' "S23 NBT"
4" Sugar S81°W 16.35' "S23 NBT"
Set sq'd cedar post adjacent.

(H9) Set 1"IDx28" I.pipe with 2" alum. MDNR cap. Set measuring nail with MDNR tag in the side of:
10" Sugar N34°E 23.1' mrkd "1/4S NBT"
14" Hemlock S33°E 20.85' do
6" Sugar S32°W 22.3' do
7" Sugar N48°W 23.85' do
Set sq'd cedar post adjacent.
