According to the field notes of his survey of the east line of section 1, T50N, R31W, Norman Thompson, RLS #4348 reestablished this corner by measurement from the S½ corner of section 33, T51N, R30W on 11 September 1946. Mr. Thompson monumented the corner with a hemlock post.

Mr. Thompson's corner location was further perpetuated by Robert Schmeling, RLS #8317 and monumented with a 1" diameter iron pipe with 4" brass cap found projecting 18" above ground.
