I, Michael Mileski, in a field survey on November, 19 96 do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

A-1; Northwest Corner Section 6, T50N, R31W;

Originally established during U.S. Survey conducted by William Burt, D.S. in 1846 and monumented with an ironwood post witnessed by a Hemlock 30 S15°E 32 lks. and a Sugar 16 S70°W 7 lks.

No subsequent record of this corner was found.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

A-1; Northwest Corner Section 6, T50N, R31W;

Found a 1 1/4" diameter iron pipe projecting 18" above ground in the vicinity of the corner. This monument bears S75°E a distance of 17.23 feet from the proportioned position. This corner is not mentioned in the field notes of Norman Thompson, RLS #4348. Furthermore, there is no physical evidence of U.S. bearing tree remains from this monument. I considered the corner lost and reestablished it at the proportioned position.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

A-1; Northwest Corner Section 6, T50N, R31W;

Set a 1"(I.D.) x 36" galvanized iron pipe with a 2" aluminum cap stamped as to location projecting 16" above ground.

Set 7" spike	NW/side	11" Sugar Maple	N45°E	29.26'
Set 7" spike	NE/side	9" Sugar Maple	S52°E	28.62'
Set 7" spike	SE/side	11" Sugar Maple	S34°W	14.42'
Set 7" spike	SW/side	7" Sugar Maple	N63°W	17.14'
		Location Post	North	1.0'

All of the above new bearing trees are marked with upper and lower blazes. The lower blaze is scribed "NBT". Both blazes as well as a band around the tree at the upper blaze are painted red.

* This corner is also M-1 of T50N, R32W.
