Originally established during U.S. Survey conducted by William Burt, D.S. in 1845 and monumented with a wood post witnessed by a

According to a Land Corner Recordation Certificate filed by Robert Crampton, P.S. #24591 and recorded 20 December 1984 in Liber 2 page 119, Houghton County Records, a "1 (in.) iron rod in the centerline of an old road bed and on a projection of two old fences East and West of the corner" was recovered and accepted. A Certificate of Survey prepared by Mr. Crampton dated 23 November 1984 indicates for the mile north of the township corner there is a deflection of 0°48'24" to the west at the ¼ corner with the south one half mile measuring 2642.97 feet and the north one half mile measuring 2642.97 feet and the north one half mile measuring the south one-half mile measuring 2642.87 feet and the north one-half mile measuring 2642.56 feet. The Sturgeon River crosses the south one-half mile once and the north one-half mile twice. Mr. Crampton recovered a 1" square pin at the E½ Cor. Sec. 36, T52N, R34W and a 1" hexagonal pin at the NE Cor. Sec. 36, T52N, R34W.

To the south of the township corner an iron rod was recovered and is most likely monumenting an original corner position. See LCRC, recorded 30 July 1996, Liber 4 page 623, Baraga County Records, filed by myself. The W¼ Cor. Sec. 6, T51N, R33W is considered lost. This mile measured 5322.77 feet (US=5306.40')

Mr. Crampton did not remonument the corner. He noted the following new bearing trees:

Presently alive and 13" in diameter having a nail and metal tag marked "RLS 24591" facing the monument. Set a 7" spike on the N/side.

6" Cedar

6" Cedar N40°W 30.2' Presently alive and 7" in diameter leaning heavily to the east and having a nail and metal tag marked "RLS 24591" facing the monument.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

This road extends south along the range line in various stages of improvement to approximately ¼ mile south of the W¼ Cor. Sec. 18, T51N, R33W. To the north this road is unused and overgrown and extends an unknown distance. Six feet north of the corner an old partially down cedar post fence extends to the east. Replaced the found iron rod with a 1"(I.D.) x 36" galvanized iron pipe with a 2" aluminum cap. Accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
