Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration: B-7; One-quarter Corner common to Sections 18 and 19, T51N, R33W; APPROVED LAND CORNER P.A. 345 OF 1990 Baraga County See back of form. B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: B-7; One-quarter Corner common to Sections 18 and 19, T51N, R33W; Recovered the BLM monument and all accessories as described in Part A. From this monument a hemlock stump hole bears S46°W a distance of 27 lks, and a cedar stump bears N31°E a distance of 12 lks. as stated by the BLM. I left the BLM monument in place and stamped the cap "PA 345 1996". Accepted as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

B-7; One-quarter Corner common to Sections 18 and 19, T51N, R33W;

- A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
  - B-7; One-quarter Corner common to Sections 18 and 19, T51N, R33W;

Originally established during U.S. Survey conducted by Harvey Mellen, D.S. in 1845 and monumented with a maple post witnessed by a

Hemlock 14 S46°W 27 lks. and a Cedar 12 N31°E 12 lks.

During the course of a survey conducted by Stephen Douglas of the Bureau of Land Management from 10 May 1984 to 10 November 1984 and approved 23 September 1985, this corner was remonumented with a 2½" x 30" aluminum pipe with cap stamped as to location from the remains of both U.S. bearing trees. Specifically, the BLM field notes state that from the monument " a decayed cedar stump, 15 ins. diam., bears N31°E,12 lks. dist., the fallen trunk alongside has no mks. visible" and " a decayed hemlock stump, size indeterminate, bears S46°W, 27 lks. dist., with no mks. visible". The BLM noted the following new bearing trees:

Hemlock 15 S16°W 27 lks. (17.82')

Presently alive and 22" in dia. having a partially open lower blaze with scribing visible.

Set 7" spike E/side Measured S08°W 17.82'

Hemlock 10 N44°W 95½ lks. (63.03')

Presently alive and 16" in dia. having a healed lower blaze.

Set 7" spike NE/side Measured N50°W 62.28'

- C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position:
  - B-7; One-quarter Corner common to Sections 18 and 19, T51N, R33W;

Found 2½" dia. aluminum pipe with 3" aluminum cap appropriately stamped as to location as set by the BLM in 1984.

All of the above new bearing trees are marked with upper and lower blazes, scribed "NBT", and painted red.

The following new bearing trees were established by the BLM in 1984. The condition of each is described in Part A.

Set 7" spike E/side 22" Hemlock S08°W 17.82' Set 7" spike NE/side 16" Hemlock N50°W 62.28'

The above BLM new bearing trees were painted red.
