I, Stephan J. Szyszkoski, in a field survey on 05/09/2011 do hereby state
that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2
above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey
instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of
a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with
the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established,
re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded
on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(SMC north of F3) Special Meander Corner on the N-S 1/4 line of Section 4, at Keweenaw Bay.
Previously established by R.W.Crampton PS, date unknown, who set a 3/4" ID iron pipe being the NW
corner of a subdivision of Government Lots 1 and 2, Section 4, 1185.91' north of Quarter corner F3.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(SMC north of F3) Found a 3/4" ID iron pipe in good condition with the following witness trees
bearing a nail and tag stamped "Survey Point LLS 24591 Do Not Disturb": 7" W.Birch S86E 15.9', 6"
Spruce S53E 35.7', 10" Spruce S20W 17.1'. I found the distance south to Quarter corner F3 to be
1185.78'. I note that the bearing of the line south from this monument to F3 is parallel to the east
line of Section 4 (G2 to G3) and I accept the monument as a careful and faithful determination of the
N-S 1/4 line of Section 4, being on the line between Government Lots 2 and 3. The monument may not
mark the true position of the SMC, i.e., not at the statutory OHWM of Lake Superior.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(SMC) Found 3/4" iron pipe projecting 12" a.g.
Set measuring nail with MDNR tag in the side of:
6" Spruce N05W 6.8' mrkd "MC BT"
6" Spruce S86E 3.35' do
6" Spruce S16E 11.65' do
7" W.Birch S62W 14.7' do
Set sq'd Cedar post adjacent.
Bearings are magnetic.
