B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

West to occupied fence corner and found capped iron set by J. Miller in 1992.
(L.1612, P.887) Iron was set at occupation and no research was done. Dug
around at the occupation and in one area found a very large rock with several
smaller rocks around. Held the large rock as a good perpetuation of the
original corner. This falls 1.5' West of the Miller Iron.

Nail and spotter in Twin 20" Cherry, N 80°E, 1.8'
Nail and spotter in 10" Cherry, S 10°W, 8.6'
Nail and spotter in 6" Hickory, North, 10.2'
