

Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(C-7) This Corner is being perpetuated as part of the Chippewa County Remonificat

Program.

Found no evidence of original corner. Found a 1-1/4" pipe (old) nearly original carried of Easterly side of 2-Track. Several local residents recall this pipe being in platform. the late 1920's. We also recovered (1) witness from the undated information (Cedar 9" N65°W 15'). Accepted position as found and set a 3/4" x 48" rebar and stamped the aluminum Chippewa County Remonumentation cap.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
