

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

1908 - Chippewa County Surveyor Frederick H. Brown, RLS 944. Drawing of Section 26 shows the West ¼ comer midway between section corners 2627 feet north and south.

1991 - Keith R. Waters, P.S. 33142, LCRC Liber 7, page 340, Chippewa County corner records. Found no evidence of corner. Set corner by single proportionate measurement between the northwest and continued and of Section 26. Corner falls on the extension of a fence line to the east. Set ½" iron with cap #33142 SPEWA

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

EROVUMET This corner is being perpetuated as part of the Chippewa County Remonumentation Program.

Found a ½" iron with cap #33142 approximately 3.5 feet below the gravel road surface of Hancock Road. considerable amount of fill has been placed on the roads in this area since the 1991 recording of this corner. Placed a 3/4" rebar with a plastic Chippewa County Remonumentation cap over the found iron and established new witness objects.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Placed a ¾" x 24" rebar with a plastic Chippewa County Remonumentation cap at the corner location, on top of a found ½" iron with cap #33142. Corner falls in the centerline of a north-south gravel road (Hancock Road), on the extension of a fence line to the east. STE OF MICHIEN
