

1845 - Original corner established by James H. Mullett. Witnesses: Cedar 10, N59°E 18 links - Hemlock 10, S47°W 16 links.

1908 – Chippewa County Surveyor Frederick H. Brown, RLS 944. Notes for Section 25 indicate, "compressor burning."

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

NOVUME This corner is being reestablished as part of the Chippewa County Remonumentation Program.

Found no evidence of the corner. Reestablished corner by single proportionate measurement on line between the section corner at K-9 to the west and the section corner on the meridian at M-9 to the east. Reestablished corner falls 3.5'± south of the centerline of Highway M-48, on a fence line to the south, 1'± east of a fence line to the north.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner;

Placed a ¾" x 24" rebar with a plastic Chippewa County Remonumentation cap in a monument box at the corner location, which falls 3.5'± south of the centerline of Highway M-48, on a fence line to the south, 1'± east of a fence line to the north
