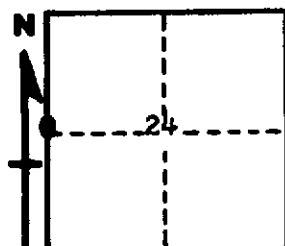

Found 3" square post and rocks. Set cedar post with square top 5.00' North.

W $\frac{1}{4}$ corner identified by E.K. Robinson on Dec. 14, 1911 from U.S. Elm, 10', S. 55° E., 19.8 ft.
Found Robinson's 3 in. square by 5 ft. long stake with stones around the stake for corner and also found his bearing trees. See County Records

Restored E&W $\frac{1}{4}$ Line as established by Charlevoix County Surveyor, William Miller, on June 11th. A.D. 1869 in the survey for a road, as recorded on page 31 of Marion Township Clerk's Record dated June 16, 1869.

Restoration accomplished by running a straight line from W $\frac{1}{4}$ corner easterly to a point at the intersection of old line fence with the west shore line of Nowland Lake. This line generally follows the center line of old grade.
