A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Original survey by Wells Burt, D.S. in 1851.

Original Bearing Trees: 16" yellow pine N15°E 29 links (19.14 feet)  
12" white pine N63°E 50 links (33.00 feet)

1988-Gary L. Pisoni, RLS #27457 found and replaced 3/4" iron pin set by unknown persons; with a 2" x 30# aluminum pipe monument with a 3" cast aluminum cap stamped to identify the corner from which he established:

8" balsam N44°E 31.62'  
8" balsam N72°E 29.74'  
2" tamarack S72°E 5.41'  
6" steel sign post S50°E 1.17'

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
