I, John R. Garske, in a field survey on June 17, 1997, do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Professional Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 4 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

On July 29, 1847, William Burt, D.S. established the corner and the following bearing trees:

12" Cedar N47°E 6 links

9" Cedar S79°W 18 links

In 1980 Richard Drahn, R.L. S. #21564 found a Michigan Conservation Department monument and established witness objects (see Section C below).

Recorded Liber 3, page 289.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I found a monument and witness objects as noted in Richard Drahn's Certificate. The corner was set by Shadko, a surveyor for the Michigan Conservation Dept. in 1943. He found a 4"x 4" cedar stake inscribed 1225 ft. to the E 1/4 corner as shown in his notes I received from the MDNR surveyor Steve Syszkoski.
