C.C. established 66 links SE from Mile #24 by A. Merryweather on July 15, 1852. Original B.Ts -- Hemlock 18" N 55 E, 28 links, (18.48')--- Hemlock 14" n 20 W, 33 links, (21.78')

Corner restored by Richard L. Drahn, R.L.S. 21564 on 6/9/75 from the remains of the two bearing trees and at record distance from Mile # 24. He set a 2" X 5' iron pipe with a 3" brass cap stamped to identify the corner. He blazed and scribed the following B.T.s -- 9" Sugar Maple N.75 E., 33.0 ft. --- 5" Yellow Birch N.11 E., 23.5 ft. --- 6" Yellow Birch N.26 W., 30.7 ft. --- 7' Steel Rail North, 2.2 ft.

Corner recorded in Liber 1, Page 127 of Corners on 1/27/76.
