

Corner re-established by proportionate methods by Earl Harrington in 1928 on a dependent re-survey of the State Line. He set a standard brass capped concrete monument and two new B.T.s --- Y. Birch 18" S.06-45 W. 13.9' ---Cedar 10" N.32-40 W. 35.3' ---

Daniel K. Pleoger (Wisc. No. S-1537) recovered the concrete monument and the remains of the 1928 B.T.s and established the following new B.T.s on 10/11/88: B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
