Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration: Original corner established by Austin Burt on 9/17/1848. Original bearing trees: Hemlock 12 S.38° E. 26 links (17.16')12" Hemlock North 21 links (13.86')B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: I restored the corner position at record bearing and distance from the remains of the two original bearing trees. The first one is a large, shallow windthrown depression. The second one is now a 18-24" badly decayed Hemlock stump. The ½ mile distance east and west to monumented section corners is in accord with the field notes of the original Government survey. A 3" squared X 6' long Cedar picket bears S.55° W., 35.3' from the original corner location. Corner research on file with Gogebic County records.
