

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

C.E. Haight and Wm. Beck, on 4/17/35 recovered a scribed Y. Birch and Sugar Maple at this location. They set a location poster on SW side of a 10" Hemlock. The corner lay SW 10 paces.

Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Restored the corner position at record bearing and distance from the remains of the two original bearing trees. The first is a badly decayed 20-24" Yellow Birch stump. The second one is now a stump hole with fragments of badly decayed Sugar Maple wood in the root holes.

Although unable to find the 1935 location poster, the tag tree is now a 15" Hemlock stub bearing N.40 E., 34.0'.

A 3/4" X 4' iron pipe bears S.01° W., 6.2'. A downed 4" X 5' squared Cedar post bears S.63° W., 4.5' from the original corner.
