A Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

B Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Corner position found marked by a 1/2" copper rod with a plastic cap stamped R.L.S. 21583 (Brian Taavola). Copper rods location is consistent with the field notes of the original survey and appears to have been used in surveys in Section 32.

C Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

At the corner position and over the top of the copper rod, I set a 2 1/2" diameter by 30" long aluminum monument with a 3 1/4" aluminum cap with magnet stamped to read: T.48N., R.35W.; 1/4; S-31, S-32; 1994; R.L.S. 21564 from which I established the following new blazed and scribed bearing trees and/or objects:
