## A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(G11) Section Corner common to Sections 27-28-33-34. Corner reestablished in 1953 by Billy D. Buckler, RLS, by Double Proportionate Measurement. Buckler placed a 1" pipe with 4" brass cap at the corner and marked the following NBTs: 14" Hemlock, S74E 48 links, 12" W. Pine N72W 78 links.

(K11) Section corner common to Sections 25-26-35-36. Corner remonumented in 1953 by Billy D. Buckler, in the original position, as determined from one original B.T. Buckler placed a 1" pipe with 4" brass cap at the corner and marked the following new bearing trees: 14" Cedar N55E 45 links, 10" Hemlock S40E 56 links.

## B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(G11) Found the 1953 monument, a 1" I.D. iron pipe capped with a 4" dia. brass Michigan Dept. of Conservation tablet, in good condition, and at record bearing and distance from the 1953 accessories. The 1953 scribing is visible on the Hemlock, which is now dead, and the W. Pine was found as a cut stump. Left the monument in place, and marked 4 new witnesses as described below.

(K11) Recovered the 1953 monument, a 1" I.D. iron pipe capped with a 4" dia. brass Michigan Dept. of Conservation tablet, in good condition, and at record bearing and distance from the remaining Cedar NBT, in good condition. The 1953 Hemlock was not recovered. Left the monument in place and marked three new accessories as described below.

## C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(G11) Found 1" pipe with 4" brass MI Dept. of Conservation tablet.

Blazed and scribed the following new bearing trees:

8" Hemlock S25E 17.9' "S34 NBT"

7" Y. Birch S43W 2.7' "S33 NBT"

5" Sugar N42W 9.6' "S28 NBT"

8" Hemlock N56E 6.9' "S27 NBT"

Bearings are magnetic.

(K11) Found 1" pipe with 4" brass MI Dept. of Conservation tablet. Blazed

and scribed the following:

4" Sugar S62E 14.4' "S36 NBT"

16" Hemlock S38W 36.5' "S35 NBT"

8" Y. Birch N45W 12.5' "S26 NBT"
