I, MARINUS MULDER, in a field survey on SEPT. 24, 1997, do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

**NOTE:** Not more than 4 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:  
THIS CORNER WAS FIRST ESTABLISHED BY U.S. DEPUTY SURVEYOR NOAH BROOKFIELD IN 1837. A WOOD POST WAS SET WITNESSED BY A 10" BEECH N22°E 27 LINKS AND A 10" BEECH S85°W 20 LINKS.

THERE IS NO RECORDED INFORMATION IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR RECORDS FOR K-9.

THE IONIA COUNTY ROAD COMMISSION IMPROVED HAWLEY HIGHWAY IN 1959. THE COUNTY ROAD COMMISSION WITNESSES FOR K-9 FOUND ON THE SECTION CORNER INDEX MAP IS: 10" ELM N.E. 43.53 FEET; 30" ELM W.N.W. 38.25 FEET; 24" MAPLE N.E. 57.35 FEET; 30" MAPLE N.W. 44.82 FEET

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:  
AT THE INTERSECTION OF HAWLEY HIGHWAY AND A FENCE LINE EAST AND WEST FOUND A RAILROAD SPIKE ON THE PAVEMENT SURFACE. ONE OF THE COUNTY WITNESS TREES REMAIN BEING THE 30" MAPLE N.W. MEASURED 43 FEET TO THE MAPLE. EXCAVATED BENEATH THE SPIKE AND AT A DEPTH OF 6" FOUND A 3/4" x 6" BOAT SPIKE. BELOW THE BOAT SPIKE FOUND A 5/8" SQUARE STEEL ROD 20" LONG, WITH BROKEN PIECES OF BRICK AT ITS BASE. NO OTHER EVIDENCE WAS FOUND.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:  
SET A 24" MONUMENT WITH A 4" DIAMETER CAP STAMPED "IONIA COUNTY-25863" IN PLACE OF THE EXISTING MONUMENTATION WITNESSED BY:

NAIL & TAG EAST SIDE 42" MAPLE N30°W 43.07 FEET  
NAIL & TAG SOUTH SIDE POWER POLE S88°W 60.38 FEET  
NAIL & TAG WEST SIDE 24" MAPLE N18°E 68.48 FEET  
CENTERLINE 3" HICKORY S42°E 70.00 FEET  
ROAD CENTERLINE ± 1 FOOT WEST
