East Meander Corner between Sections 17 and 20, T44N, R32W

I, Gary L. Pisoni, in a field survey on November 7, 1997 do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Original corner established by Zelotes B. Searls, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, in July 1849.

Original Corner: Wood post

Original Bearing Trees:

Hemlock	10"	S58°E	23 links(15.18 feet)
W. Pine	18"	N76°E	17 links (11.22 feet)

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

No evidence of original B.T.s found

Found a 3/4" iron pipe located on the East edge of Light Lake as the meander corner as shown on the Houlmont Unrecorded Plat of Gov't Lot No. 1 - Section. 17.

Accepted iron pipe as the best available evidence for restoring corner position. I set a W.C. M.C. 8.0 feet East from Meander Corner on higher ground.

Corner record research on file with County Representative.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

At the W.C. M.C. position, set a 3/4" outside diameter aluminum rod monument, 4 feet long, flush with ground surface and stamped as follows: Iron County Remonumentation, T44N, R32W; 8.0' West, W.C., M.C., S-17, S-20 1997, RLS-27457 from which I established the following bearing trees: (All measurements taken to a nail in side of tree)
No scribing or signs on B.T.s. All ties are to the W.C. M.C.
