A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

No evidence of original corner or bearing tree remains. Corner position found marked by anima30" iron pin located on the East/West wire fence line and 5' from waters edge. Corner position has been used and accepted as the corner locally, for many years. Layed iron pin next to aluminum rod monument as described below. Monument is 3" above ground surface.

This corner is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

At the corner position, I set a 3/4" outisde diameter by 3 feet long aluminum rod monument with a 3" cast aluminum cap, stamped to read: Iron County Remonumentation, T44N, R33W, M.C., S-35, S-2, T43N, 1993, R.L.S. 27457; from which I established the following new blazed and scribed bearing trees: (all measurements taken to a nail in side of tree) STATE OF MCA
