Szyszkoski, in a field survey on C9 03/12/15 do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(C9) Corner common to Sections 19-20-29-30. 1977 - Corner remonumented by A.O.Enger RLS at the position of a found Northern Paper Mills monument which had been set at record bearing and distance from the original BTs in 1953. Set 1" IDx36" I.pipe with 3 3/4" alum. cap. Sugar Maple 5" N65°E 13.1', Sugar Maple 7" S45°E 34.2'.

(E6) Quarter corner common to Sections 16 and 17. 1953 record of S.R. Wickman and N.J.Peryam of Northern Paper Mills Forestry Division state: Orig. B.T.s - Tam 8 N40°E 4; Tam. 8 S35°W 31; 12/24/35 - B.G.Buell and Seppala found Tam. 8 N40°E 4 dry stub face plain, Tam 8 S35°W 31 broken stub I.M.; 12/29/49 - D.Buell and Peryam found Tam 8 N40°E 4 dry stub I.M. faint; 3/12/53 - S.Wickman & Peryam found Tam 8 N40°E 4 dry stub I.M. faint, old weasel marks and Reg's. Set pipe [& brass cap] from Tam. B.T. Spruce 6 S73°E 22, Spruce 6 N43°E 26.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(C9) Found the 1977 monument in good condition and at record bearing and distance from the 1977 accessories, both in good condition with overgrown blazes. Accepted the monument as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner.

(E6) Found the 1953 NPM capped pipe, in good condition, at record bearing and distance from the 1953 NBTs. The Spruce SE is a 2' tall rotting stump with face, the Spruce NE is a rotted stump. Accepted the monument as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(C9) Found 1"ID I.pipe with 3 3/4" alum. MDNR cap. Set measuring nail with MDNR tag in the side of:
 9" Sugar N70°E 13.1' old blazes (1977 NBT)
 10" Sugar S45°E 34.6' do do
 12" Y.Birch N45°W 39.5' mrkd "S19 NBT"
 6" Sugar N17°W 28.9' do

(E6) Found 1"ID I.pipe with brass NPM cap. Set measuring nail with MDNR tag in the side of:
 5" B.Spruce N14°E 16.0' mrkd "1/4S NBT"
 5" B.Spruce S45°E 26.1' do
 5" Tamarack S57°W 18.6' do
 5" Tamarack N68°W 17.3' do
 Set sq'd spruce post adjacent.
