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

corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:



A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

K13 - corner common to sections 35 & 36, T25N, R7W, & sections 1 & 2, T24N R7W

- 1839 GLO survey of township lines by John Brink set post corner 35 & 36 1) W. Pine 12" N84°W 12; 2) Beech 8" N59°E 19.
- 1854 GLO subdivision resurvey by Thomas Whelpley corner witness trees 3) Beech 4" N63½°E 18; 4) W. Pine 12" N-W 12.
- 1915 Fargo Engineering Map #3412, found one US witness, conventional iron crockery monument set. -5) W. Pine stp. 12" N24°E 0.19; 6) W. Pine stp. 24" N63½°E 0.44; 7) W. Pine stp. 20" N34½°W 0.93.
- 1965 DNR Corner Record Kenneth Ostling, PS #10068. This corner was found while making a survey on this township line. Found 3/4" pipe in place which I concluded was established by Fargo Engineering, for Consumers Power Company, probably in late 1900's. Bent-over pipe and broken crockery identify it as Fargo. Site for at least one possible OBT in place. Checks exactly with stream crossing East. An L.E.S. post is about four chains North, but must be disregarded as these posts were not intended to properly mark the corner. Checks okay for bearing of township line. - Set 1" pipe with 4" aluminum cap. - 8) 8" R. Oak S68°W 71.3'; 9) 7" Maple N38°W 79.4'.
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or re-establishing corner:

K13 - corner common to sections 35 & 36, T25N, R7W, & sections 1 & 2, T24N R7W

Found 4" aluminum DOC cap on 1" pipe and witnesses per the 1965 DNR corner record. Found stump and stump remains of Fargo witnesses fitting the position of the monument. The found 4" aluminum DOC cap on 1" pipe is accepted as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

K13 - stamped 4" aluminum DOC cap on 1" pipe. - Set Blue Post 1' North.

N48°E 74.36' to set nail & tag in NW. side 5" W. Pine S55°E 2.64' to found nail in 10" W. Pine N86°W 17.28' to found nail in S. side 18" W. Pine N35°W 78.62' to found nail in SW. side 7" Maple in clump of 4
