

- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or re-establishing corner:
- 9 CE 1/16 corner of Section 20. Found ½" x 18" rebar per Parker LCRC and witnesses #3 a stump and #4 fitting position. Steel fence post next to rebar. Found no county surveyor evidence. Replace found ½" X 18" rebar with a stamped 2" aluminum cap on a 5/8" X 34" rebar.
- 13 ~ SE 1/16 corner of section 20. Set stamped 2" aluminum Cap on 5/8" x 34" rebar per standard BLM procedure.
- C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
- 9 A stamped 2" aluminum cap on a 5/8" x 34" rebar. Replaced steel fence post 1' North.
