

- A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
- <u>E8</u> <u>1852</u> GLO, G. Cannon Set ¼ sec. post
 - 1) Tamarack 16" S50°E 25
 - 2) W. Pine 12" \$80°W 26
 - 1901 County Surveyor, Merrill FB 20, p. 67, shows corner
 - 1959 DNR corner record, K. J. Ostling, PS#10068. Found the government post from both BT's. The SW W. Pine in place with good marks and the SE Tamarack in place with evidence of face. Checks swamp edge & line tree north.

Set 1" Pipe with 4" Brass Cap.

- 3) 7" Cedar S35°W 32 1/2 L.
- 4) 10" Cedar S69°E 22 1/2 L.
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or re-establishing corner:
- E8 1/4 corner common to sections 20 & 21, T26N, R6W. Found 4" Department of Conservation (DOC) brass cap on 1" galvanized iron pipe and witnesses #3 & #4 fitting position per the 1959 Ostling corner record. Found stump remains of both GLO Bearing trees, fitting position. Marks still visible on White Pine stump. Witness #3 in good shape, witness #4 is dead but still standing. DOC brass monument accepted as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner.
- C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
- E8 Found 4" stamped DOC brass cap on 1" galvanized iron pipe

N47°E 13.22' to set nail & tag in NW. side 7" Cedar S65°E 14.5' to notch on face of 12" dead standing Cedar (#4) S30°E 9.79' to set nail & tag in NE. side 10" Cedar S40°W 21.70' to set nail & tag in SE. side 10" Cedar (#3) N62°W 36.13' to set nail & tag in N. side 8" Cedar scribed "XBT" Set blue Carsonite post 1' Northeast
