S82°E 56.38' 26" Maple, found nail  
N15°W 113.70' power pole, found nail

Part B: Surveyor's Report on Perpetuation, Restoration, Reestablishment, or Monumentation of Corner

K10 – ¼ corner common to sections 25 & 26 T27N R6W

Found Kalkaska County aluminum monument (5/8" rebar with remon cap) in centerline North-South gravel road. Found two accessories in good condition from Remonumentation LCRC fitting position of the monument. Power pole was gone, found stump of the 26" Maple. Accepted the monument as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.
