B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(SMC) Established the position for the corner on the N-S 1/4 line of Sec. 34, having a bearing which is the weighted mean bearing of the east and west Section lines, and 1840.00' south of the monumented Center of Section 34. The corner falls 22' south of a swamp edge and lies on the northern edge of a 2.5' high berm which supports emerging vegetation. The northing is a position of convenience. not attempt to mark the Ordinary High Water Mark of Lake Superior.

(MC 5) Found the 2007 monument of record, in good condition and at record bearing and distance from the 9" forked Tamarack NBT and the 1" pipe on the section line. The 3" W.Birch and 2" Spruce NBTs were not recovered. Accepted the monument as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.
