A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

1838- S. SIBLEY, G.L.O. #1 – 14" Sugar S36°W 29 Links #2 – 10" Hemlock N23°E 19 Links Stream running E. & W. is 462' South 1899 – J.W. Nichoson

Measured 2593.14' North to Section corner 1906 – J.W. Nichoson "Old Corner Identified" Set Railroad Iron.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring of reestablishing corner:

I found Cole's ½" re-bar over old railroad rail at the intersection of roads West and South. I measured 422 feet South to a Creek running through a culvert approximately 15 feet below road surface. The drainage basin for creek is fairly wide at this location.

Condition of the accessories are as follows: #1 gone, #2 Gone, #3 Gone, #4 Gone, #5 Found in good condition, #6 Found in good condition, #7 Found in good condition.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

I replaced the ½" re-bar with a ¾" x 24" re-bar with Lake County Brass Cap, and is accepted as a careful and faithful re-establishment of the position of the original corner.
