

1978 Paul Lapham P.S. 9433 recorded corner in page 260 Luce County Corner Records. The corner form shows a 2" pipe for the corner along with one of the original hemlock bearing trees at S 45° W, 8.58' for a witness.

1979 East Lake Subdivision #4, survey by Paul Lapham, P.S. 9433, shows meander corner and witnesses as recorded in 1978.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(1-5 /1-6) Witness Corner to the Meander Corner Common to Sections 15 and 14, T. 45 N., R. 11 W. This corner is being perpetuated as part of the Luce County Remonumentation Program.

Found no evidence of the original corner or the pipe or bearing tree as recorded in 1978. The position for the corner now falls in East Lake. Recovered the two lot corners and the concrete monument as recorded and computed a position for the corner. Established a witness corner to the meander corner at the intersection of the section line with the North line of lot 88 of East Lake Subdivision #4, 59.26' South of the original corner position.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner.

(I-5 / I-6) Witness Corner to the Meander Corner Common to Sections 15 and 14, T. 45 N., R. 11 W. Corner is a 1/2" x 48" re-bar with a stamped aluminum Luce County Remonumentation cap. The corner falls 40'-South of the shore of East Lake.
