I, Stephan J. Szyszkoski, in a field survey on _____, 19____ do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(C7) Corner common to Sections 17-18-19-20. 1969: Billy D. Buckler, RLS reestablished by single proportionate measure between Section corners 1 mile North and South. The position fell in the center of N-S grade. Set 5/8"x16" iron bar. 2002: The 1969 monument was recovered, remitted and rerecorded in absence of measurements to adjacent corners by the undersigned. Found 5/8" iron bar and placed plastic cap atop. 6" Balsam N56E 52.2', 8" Cedar S54E 28.65', 8" Cedar S11E 69.9', 5" Maple S87W 35.55'.

(87) Quarter corner common to Sections 18-19. 1849: Established by Guy Carleton: "East corrected between Sections 18 and 19...41.10 Set post for 1/4 section corner. Hemlock 12 S40W 16 links, Hemlock 14 N28E 8 links. ...81.10 Section corner."

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(C7) The 1969 monument of record was recovered as recorded but is not accepted. I discovered that Mr. Buckler had made an arithmetic error in his 1969 calculations which led him to believe that the corner 1 mile north of this position, at C5, was 100 feet further west than it actually was on the ground. Consequently, his proportionate position for this corner is erroneous. I reestablished the corner by double proportionate measurement to the original record between Section corners 80.9465 ch. West (81.10 R), 81.4422 ch. North and South (80.00 R), and 80.6539 ch. East (80.80 R). Left the 1969 monument in place as a reference corner, it being S83 deg. 18' 52" W (true brg), 55.83' distant.

(87) The original post and accessories were not recovered. Reestablished the corner by single proportionate measurement to the original record and on the section line between Section corners 2707.47' west and 2635.01' east.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(C7) Set 1"IDx36" I.pipe with 4" alum. MDNR cap. Blazed, scribed, and set measuring nails in:
8" Balsam N25W 31.3' "S18 NBT" *
8" Cedar S60W 37.75' "S20 NBT" *
12" Cedar N28E 16.0' "S17 NBT"
5/8" iron rod in N-S rd. S88W 55.83'
Bearings are magnetic. Distances to trees are to nail/tag. * denotes re-marked 2002 NBT.

(87) Set 1"IDx36" I.pipe with 4" alum. MDNR cap. Blazed, scribed, and set measuring nails in:
6" Balsam S01E 38.65' "1/4S NBT"
6" Balsam S48E 19.65' do
5" Balsam N41E 40.6' do
6" Cedar S67W 59.2' do
Bearings are magnetic. Distances are to nail with tag.
