A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(L1) Quarter corner common to Sec. 1 T44N-R9W Mackinac Co., and Sec. 36 T45N-R9W Luce Co. Corner re-witnessed in 1968 (record dated 3/14/69) by Billy D. Buckler RLS: 2" iron pipe. 9" Twin hard maple N01W 66.2', 14" Elm S20E 59.9'
 (2-Sec. 1) East 1/16 corner between Section 1 T44N-R09W Mackinac Co. and Section 36 T45N-R09W Luce Co. Rewitnessed in 1968 (record dated 3/14/69) by Billy D. Buckler RLS. Found 2" iron pipe. No witnesses.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(L1) Recovered a 2" iron pipe in good condition at record bearing and distance from the presumed NBT Maple North, which is only a single tree, with old blazes. The elm was not recovered. Left the monument in place and marked new witnesses as described below.
 (2-Sec. 1) Found 2" ID iron pipe at edge of plantation. Made rough measurement east and west 1/4 mile to adjacent corners to check position of pipe. This corner is being recorded to update the accessories.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(L1) Found 2" ID iron pipe. Blazed, scribed, and set measuring nails in the following:	"1/4S NBT"	(2) Found 2" iron pipe. Blazed, scribed, and set measuring nails in the following:	"E1/16 BT"
