Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

C-1, T8S, R7E, Bedford Township, Monroe County - ID No. 58 Section Corner Common to Sections 5 and 6 (Secor Road at Rauch Road - Asphalt over concrete pavement) 1920, G.L.O. Surveyor Joseph Wampler, intersect N Boundary 222 links W. of post set post at intersection corner of Sections 5 and 6 and witnessed: W. Oak 8 (inch) S.88°E. 45 links & W. Oak 10 (inch) S.84°W. 30 links. 1894, A.F. Winney performed section survey monument not described. 1929, road plans show found stone at station 0+00. 1946, O.A. Case surveyed Golden Meadows Plat, Liber 9, Page 8. 1953, A.J. Marino found stone 0.1 foot west of edge of pavement. 1961, A.J. Marino witnesses note P.I. 1973, G.B. Warnke notes found railroad spike, cut "+", this spike is used by surveyors to present.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

C-1 - 9/26/1994, found 3/8 inch rebar 4 inches deep, 3.40 feet west of railroad spike. Dug a 36 inch X36 inch hole, found a stone at 22 inches deep, 2.60 feet west of railroad spike and / or 0.8 feet east of 3/8 inch rebar. Found no post under stone, set a old 1 inch X 36 inch iron pipe in place of stone. 11/30/94, placed monument box and set brass remonumentation cap on 1 inch x 36 inch iron pipe.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

C-1 - Set 1 inch X 36 inch iron pipe with brass remonumentation cap inside monument box to replace stone and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner and Witnesses: South 45° West 43.00 feet to found nail/shiner in northerly face of utility pole

South 45° East 54.46 feet to found nail/shiner in northerly face of utility pole

North 25.55 feet to northeast face of the east sign post

East 2.59 feet to found railroad spike

North 35° West 36.30 feet to found PK nail/shiner in northeast face of guy pole
