WARNKE, JR., in a field survey on SEPTEMBER 2, 19 94, do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

- A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

C-3, T8S, R7E, Corner at Sections 5, 6, 7 & 8
(At Secor Road & Samaria Road)

G.L.O. Surveyor Joseph Wampler set corner post in 1820. Witnesses: W. Oak 18 inch S.42°E. 40 links & B. Oak 7 inch N.08°W. 11 links. / Old book notes old stake with stone over per A.F. Winney in 1894. / A.J.M. found bolt in 1961. / M.D.O.T. Surveyor L.J. Czubak (No. 12581) found bolt and witnessed in March of 1964. M.D.O.T. Survey Chief Lubakka set boat spike in monument box in October of 1965. This point was used until when roads were re-aligned. During this construction period, George B. Warnke probed and dug for stone; but it was not found. To date, corner replaced by a 1/2 inch rebar in square monument box which is used

- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

C-3 - On 10/25/1993, found 1/2 inch rebar in square top monument box and witnessed as shown below. 9/2/1994, 1/2 inch rebar is concreted into bottom of monument box and could not be removed. Set brass remonumentation cap on 1/2 inch rebar.



- C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

C-3 - Found 1/2 inch rebar in square top monument box and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner and witnesses:
North 45° West 48.01' nail/shiner in southwest face of utility pole
South 40° West 53.17' nail/shiner in southeast face of utility pole
South 50° East 66.71' nail/shiner in southwest face of blinking traffic light guy pole
North 51° East 64.26' nail/shiner in northwest root of 24 inch Maple
North 42° West 37.27' notch in northeast rim of storm manhole
